What Kinds of Mammals Are Here?



The Mashpee National Wildlife Refuge is home to a variety of mammals including raccoons, red foxes, bats, white-tailed deer, squirrels, and the endangered New England cottontail.

How do I Know They Are Here?



Many mammal species are wary of humans so it may be difficult to see them. However, you can look for signs of mammal activity like tracks, scat, and food scraps like acorn shells and fish carcasses.
